Liquor Restrictions and ID Scan apply in the regions of:
Ceduna, Coober Pedy, Port Augusta and Whyalla.

ID Scan is an App developed by the SA Government



Everyone must present valid photo ID each time they buy takeaway alcohol.

Valid photo ID includes:

- Australian driver's licence
- Australian Government issued Proof of Age Card
- Passport (if you do not have a driver's licence or Proof of Age Card)

You can help by ensuring you always carry your photo ID with you when purchasing takeaway alcohol.

ID Scan is an App developed by the SA Government to assist licensees to comply with liquor restrictions. ID Scan records each purchase a customer makes of restricted items of liquor and enforces daily purchase limits.

ID Scan also identifies if a person is not permitted to buy takeaway alcohol because they are barred or live in a community where alcohol is prohibited.

ID Scan securely stores a customer's purchase history for 24 hours for the purpose of enforcing daily limits. Licensees do not have access to customer's personal information.

ID Scan and liquor restrictions are designed to reduce alcohol-related harm to individuals, families and the wider community.
