I am pleased to submit my report on barring orders for the period ending 30 June 2012 in accordance with the requirements of section 128A of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997* (the Act).

Section 128A of the Act requires that I report on details of barring orders issued by licensees for an indefinite period or a period exceeding six months.

However, all barrings (including those for less than six months) were included in the 2009-10 and 2010-11 annual reports.

Consequently, this annual report provides the information required for longer period barrings together with total barrings (including those for less than six months) in parenthesis.

Licensee Barrings - Welfare

There were 13 welfare orders made by licensees barring persons for an indefinite period or a period exceeding six months during 2011-12. The location of the licensed premises from which the persons were barred is shown in the table below.

Licensee Barrings - Other

In 2011-12, licensee barring orders issued for an indefinite period or a period exceeding six months included 105 for reasons other than welfare, compared with 294 in 2010-11 and 303 in 2009-10.

Total licensee barring orders issued in 2011-12 (including those for a period of six months or less) included 622 for reasons other than welfare, compared with 645 in 2010-11 and 898 in 2009-10.

Table 3 below details the types of conduct for which these licensee barrings were issued. Some barrings were issued for more than one reason. In 2011-12, licensees issued barrings for 114 types of conduct, compared with 372 in 2010-11 and 336 in 2009-10.

Police Barrings - Criminal Intelligence

I have been advised by South Australia Police that no barring orders were issued on the grounds of 'criminal intelligence' during the period 1 July 2011 to 30 June 2012.

Review of Orders conducted under section 128

There were 41 reviews of barring orders conducted in 2011-12 under section 128 of the Act, compared with 39 in 2010-11 and 53 in 2009-10.

The Act requires a report on the number of barring orders reviewed regardless of the length of time for which the barring was issued. The numbers reported in 2009-10 and 2010-11 are repeated for comparison purposes.
