

Late Night Trading Code of Practice

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Metal Detector Technical Specification

Pursuant to section 42 of the *Liquor Licensing Act 1997*, it is a condition of every licence that the licensee complies with the Commissioner's codes of practice.

The Late Night Trading Code of Practice (the Late Night Code) will take affect from 1 October 2013.

The Late Night Code includes a clause relating to the use of a metal detector which complies with the technical specification approved by the Liquor and Gambling Commissioner.

The approved technical specification is as follows:

The metal detector must-

1. Provide accurate detection of all ferrous, non-ferrous metals and stainless steel
2. Have visual indication
3. Have a reliable power source

If **portable** detectors are used (ie wands), the metal detector must also-

1. Have vibrating indication
2. Be water resistant
3. Have an operating bright LED flashlight
